

87 new SSTH hotel management graduates

On 26th May 2011, SSTH Swiss School of Tourism and Hospitality graduates received their hotel management diploma. With this "Round-the-World-Ticket" the new hoteliers have a head-start for their international hospitality careers.

49 graduates of the German taught program of study received the diploma "Hôtelière-Restauratrice HF respectively Hôteleur-Restaurateur HF". The majority of the graduates are from Switzerland.

After the diploma ceremony a delicious gala dinner was celebrated with a review of three years of studies and big emotions.
